



TIPS FOR A STRESS-FREE WEDDING DAY

- Be sure to have a hair and makeup trial at least a month before your wedding. This will give you peace of mind to know exactly how you will look and give you the opportunity to change things in advance if necessary. Be sure to bring all jewelry to the trial to see how makeup shades work with the pieces.
- Have your florist deliver your flowers to where you are getting ready, not the ceremony venue. Since you never know when the mood will strike for a great photo, you'll want your flowers there and ready to go.
- Find out what the photography rules are at the ceremony location. All venues are different, some restricting the location of photographs and even the times they are permitted.
- If possible, arrange to have your formal photographs taken before the ceremony. Getting this step out of the way early in the day frees up the rest of your time to spend with your guests. You will be able to go straight to cocktail hour and catch up with loved ones without stress. It's a new age, so it's no longer considered bad luck for the groom to see the bride before the wedding.
- Have food delivered to your getting-ready location. It may be hectic, but take the time to have a bite to eat before the wedding as it will be a while before you have the opportunity to nourish yourself during the reception.
- Prepare an emergency bridal kit with clear nail polish, mints, a sewing kit, stain treater, Visine, safety pins, bobby pins, pain reliever, and mini deodorant.
- Allowing 50% more time for hair and makeup than you originally anticipated alleviates the number one reason wedding schedules end up running late. This will ensure that you have plenty of time for all the portraits you want to take before the wedding.
- Make sure you discuss a "rain plan" with your venue just in case Mother Nature doesn't see sunshine in the cards.



A WEDDING DAY PHOTO TIMELINE

A wedding is a whirlwind of events, gone in the blink of an eye. There's little more important to a perfectly executed event than an organized timeline. If you are looking to effectively plan your wedding day with your wedding coordinator or fiancé, here's a look at a typical wedding photo timeline from our point of view. We are here to assist you in planning your day so you don't miss a beat



6 HOURS BEFORE THE CEREMONY

I've just finished packing my bags, and I'm now going over the wedding information form and having a meeting with my assistant to talk about the details of the day.



4 HOURS BEFORE THE CEREMONY

I leave the studio for the wedding site. The bride's hair and makeup should be well underway to leave plenty of time for family and couple photos.



) 3.5 hours before the ceremony

I arrive at the preparation site to capture the finishing touches of hair and makeup and to document the bride getting into her wedding dress and the groomsmen making their final preparations.



2.5 HOURS BEFORE THE CEREMONY

We arrange for a "first meeting" for the bride and groom where they see each other before the ceremony. Immediately after this we begin formal photographs with the entire wedding party and the bride and groom's immediate and extended families.



2 HOURS BEFORE THE CEREMONY

The bride and groom's portraits begin. We work in a variety of locations and capture a wide range of poses. About an hour before the ceremony we stop to allow you to freshen up, collect your things, and make it to the ceremony site on time.



30 MINUTES BEFORE THE CEREMONY

I leave the preparation site to set out for the ceremony site. Here I coordinate with my assistant and set up any equipment we need during the ceremony. We take a last look around and find where the light is coming from to best document the ceremony. At this time you should have a quick refreshment and take 15 minutes of quiet time with just the two of you; you'll want to regroup before all the excitement begins!



30 MINUTES AFTER THE CEREMONY

We arrive at the reception site and immediately begin photographing candid shots of arriving guests and continue into the cocktail reception. If there are any additional formal photographs desired we will take this time to finish them in plenty of time for the reception.



(\checkmark) 45 minutes after the ceremony

We enter the dining room before the guests arrive to photograph the cake and floral decor. We also take this time to set up room lights and spotlights if we find they are needed. Just before the guests arrive we touch base with the catering manager or wedding coordinator to see if there are any last-minute changes to the reception schedule.



1 HOUR AFTER THE CEREMONY

At this time we strictly document the reception candidly as it unfolds, including the first dances, toasts, dancing, and cake cutting. But don't worry, we are always available for any photo request you may have throughout the evening. Just ask!



4 HOURS AFTER THE CEREMONY

We pack our equipment and prepare for our departure. But first, we will check with you to make sure there aren't any additional photos you would like or an overtime request. We may go outside for a night "time exposure" photograph of the two of you to showcase the beauty of your location at night.

Two weeks before your wedding, we will touch base via phone or email to discuss your wedding day photo timeline. At this time we will also provide you with our Client Information form to fill out with all your wedding details, including locations, family members, special wedding day events, vendors, and much more. This information will ensure that we are all on the same page for an unforgettable and stress-free event!

FROM SHOOT TO ALBUM

The weeks prior to and directly following your wedding planning are busy times. Here at Jennifer Crenshaw Photography® we honor your harried moments with a special timeline that will help you understand how we are working our hardest to avoid any unnecessary surprises.

Two weeks before your wedding: After chatting on the phone about the day and discussing any last-minute specifications, we send you a Client Information form to fill out all the details most important to you for capturing the best images possible.

Two days before your wedding: We give you a quick check-in call to confirm all the details from the schedule and your wedding form.

The day of your wedding: We arrive at the scheduled time and quickly run through the course of the day. Then we coordinate with your family and friends regarding scheduled start times for formal portraits and what to expect.

A week after your wedding: We collect all of your wedding images, which will then be edited, archived, and prepared for your online gallery or reveal session. At this time we will also send your album questionnaire.

Four weeks after your wedding: We deliver your private online proofing gallery with all of your images.

Five weeks after your wedding: Your album images will be selected by Jennifer Crenshaw Photography[®] or by you, and your album commission will begin.

Eight weeks after your wedding: You will receive your album design to approve. At this time you can make any changes and approve your album to go into production.

Ten weeks after your wedding: You come by the studio to pick up your your album. We can also use this opportunity to take orders for portraits, wedding party member gifts, parent albums, and any of the other unique keepsakes we offer.







STRIKE A POSE

Here at Jennifer Crenshaw Photography[®], we take pride in capturing the most natural, candid portraiture possible. This style showcases your day as it was, helping to bring your personalities forward and documenting your day for a lifetime of memories.

While we shoot the majority of our images this way, it's also very important to capture traditional formal portraits as well. These group shots are best immediately when everyone is ready and fresh, right before the ceremony, and since our most important goal is getting you to your wedding on schedule, we allow 3-5 minutes for each desired grouping to ensure maximum results with minimal time. (Make sure all flowers and boutonnières are delivered on time and affixed to family members and to the wedding party in advance.)

Because we prefer to keep the number of groups to ten or less for more intimate group shots, we always start with the largest group and break it down after that to allow for mingling. As time permits, we love to include a picture of the bride with each of her bridesmaids, and the groom with each of his groomsmen, since each person who has been invited has close, personal ties with the couple.

If you have ideas for any "can't-miss" portrait groupings you would like to see photographed during this time, be sure to note them on your provided wedding information form. We're happy to work with you to capture all of your special moments!



ALBUM COMMISSIONS

Jessica and Reed's wedding album was a culmination of all the wonderful memories of the day presented in a beautiful book that tells the story for a lifetime. Because the wedding album process can be a little challenging for busy couples like the Hatleys, we provide full album services from image selection to design to cover selection, and more. Choosing from our main album line of gorgeous leatherbound books constructed from only the best quality materials and workmanship, we fashioned a professionally designed heirloom complete with personalized details for decades of enjoyment.


Parent Albums and Guest Albums


Great engagement shoot ideas:

All photographs are printed on fine detail, high resolution, archival paper that has a luxurious smooth surface. This paper is Certified for 100+ years! This means that photographs will be hung in your family's home for several generations and your grandchildren will be able to see a photo of you on one of the best days of your life.

When you book a portrait session with Jennifer Crenshaw Photography® you will receive a Reveal Session after the shoot. We look at your images in a slideshow on the big screen, and you get to choose your favorites.

We will then look through your selected images and decide the best way to display your photographs. The wall portrait is a classic and timeless option for anyone.

During your Reveal Session we will look at how your photographs will fit on the walls of your own home. How, you may ask? By sending us photos of the walls you want to see artwork on. Having the Reveal Session in your own home is another great option.

Framing and installation are also available.



FOLIO BOXES

The Folio Box is another great option for displaying your favorite photographs. These boxes look beautiful on a shelf or on a table in your home and are very versatile. It's like buying wall portraits in bulk!

The Folio Box has three print options. You can choose a box with 10, 20, or 30 matted, archival, fine art prints. All Folio Boxes are designed with an 8x12 print in an 11x14 mat. The 11x14 box is customizable and made with the highest quality materials.

For couples who want all of their photographs from their session or wedding printed, and want to give gift prints to family and friends, this is a great product for you.

Proof Boxes contain all edited images as a 5x7 or 4x6 printed photograph. The Proof Box can be customized with text and images printed directly on the box.

Also included with the Proof Box is a Flash Drive (USB) and print release. All digital images are high resolution and contain no watermarking.
